## National Survey on Special Educational Needs Support

Essex is part of a nationwide survey, called the Personal Outcomes Evaluation Tool, or 'POET' for short. The POET survey gives children, young people, parents, carers and practitioners the chance to share their views on Education Health Care Plans (EHCPs) and Special Educational Needs (SEN) support and the impact it has had on their lives. 11. In the box "Enjoy your gift..." make sure you include your name if you would like a "thank you for making a gift" in our newsletter (don't worry no gift is too small we will not mention what it was) or delete to make your gift anonymous.
12. Save gift options
13. Continue
14. Pay for your items in the usual way and the gift will be delivered to St Michael's.
