You will have two weeks to complete each one.</p> <p>The first are research based and the third is more creative:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Mountains (01.06.20) 2. Volcanos (15.06.20) 3. Poetry (29.06.20) 	<p>Hokusai was a famous Japanese artist who created beautiful paintings using ancient printing techniques. He always included Mount Fuji in his paintings.</p> <p>Your task is to find out about Hokusai and use your creativity to recreate one of his famous paintings. You can choose to paint, sketch, collage, print or a combination.</p> 	<p>In October, we looked at animations and how they were formed, using lots of images in different positions to create a movement effect.</p> <p>On Purple Mash, I have set a 2animate 2do. Linking to the Geography task, can you create an animation showing how fold mountains are formed?</p>	<p>About one-fifth of the surface of Earth is covered by mountain ranges they are large areas where many mountains can be found close together. Among the greatest ranges are the Himalaya, Andes, Rockies, Alps, Urals and Atlas.</p> <p>Your task is to create a presentation about how fold mountains are formed. You can use PowerPoint, posters, models or a written piece. Include images to explain the process.</p> 	<p>All living things and their habitats; vertebrates and invertebrates.</p> <p>Miss Morris will be sending you a short lesson video next week about this Scientific concept.</p> <p>Your task will be to create a 3D model of an invertebrate and a vertebrate.
