






We will confirm whether we have been able to offer your child a place in their desired clubs by letter as usual.

While school run clubs on offer are free of charge, all fees for externally run clubs should be paid in advance. Children will not be allowed to attend if payment has not been received. Please see the attached leaflets regarding the Tennis Club and the Cricket Club for Years 5&6 by Essex Professional Coaching (EPC).

Times Table Rockstars: a great place for your child to practise their times-tables.

Mindfulness Colouring: gives the children the opportunity for a relaxing exercise during lunchtime

Intergenerational Community Club: children will be communicating with Manor Lodge in a variety of ways for example, letter writing, teams call etc.

Ukulele: children must be able to play a minimum of three chords

Recorders: children must be able to play a minimum of three notes

Film Club: watching and discussing age-appropriate films

Lunchtime Learning: opportunity for children to access help with their homework or work with Mrs Fletcher on any areas they are having difficulties with. Just drop in and sign up on the day!

Art Club: different art activities throughout the term

Gardening Club: working in the school garden planting, maintaining, and harvesting
