Safeguarding

<u>Omegle App-</u> The following information has come from 'The 2 Johns' who offer training, webinars and pupil sessions to many schools in Essex. They also provide advice for parents via their website <u>Home-eSafety Training</u>

'We have been working in primary schools since Easter and have been shocked by the number of Year 5 & 6 children who were talking about Omegle. In our experience, any visit to Omegle will lead you to see any numbers of men often displaying inappropriate sexual behaviour on screen. It is a camera chat site that has the strap line 'Talk to Strangers'. The site asks you to confirm you are 18 before allowing access, but has no age verification mechanism in place.

The children told us that many You Tubers use Omegle and encourage them to use the site (presumably getting paid to do so). Of particular concern, many children said they were fans of the huge you tuber 'SSSniperWolf' who uses the site.

We know from previous operational experience that paedophiles use Omegle looking to interact with children, recording the live streams that the children engage with for later use.

We have seen the level of awareness of Omegle in Primary Schools increasing in the last couple of months and are worried that parents/carers have no concept of it. Although Omegle is an app, children are telling us that they use their web browser to access the app, rather than downloading it, to avoid their parents knowing they are using it. We hope that by raising this issue . parents and carers are better placed to evaluate if it requires any consideration from them at home. This message is put out as an advisory note.'
